

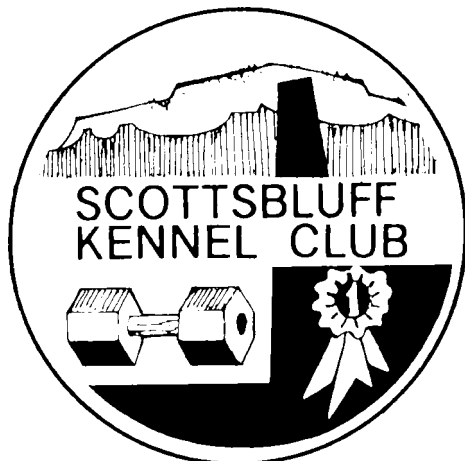

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

BRACE CLASS - Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and both dogs must be entered in another class.

The above classification is provided for all breeds (and varieties). Additional divisions, i.e. (age, color or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 1:00 pm Friday, April 2, 2010. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

Exhibitors will be responsible for the cleanliness of their areas.

No double handling will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring in any manner will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

RV parking only will be allowed in designated RV parking areas: \$25.00 per night advance reservation, \$30.00 per night day of show. Deadline for advance reservation is March 11, 2009. Large vehicles may require two spaces. 15 Amp 110 volt electricity for each spot with water available. There are only 70 spaces. There is a dump station available on the grounds.

Sandford Hall has been designated a Historical Building; therefore, extreme caution must be used in care of building. **NO TAPE ALLOWED TO MARK GROOMING AREA ON THE FLOOR.** Additional grooming in Quonset Building, north of Events Center & under stadium - south of Events Center. Grooming - Additional grooming in open-sided show barn, north of Events Center, electrical outlets available.

No crating or exercise pens in the Events Center Building. Limited crating only for handicapped & to be removed immediately after breed judging.

On Sunday, April 4, 2010, groups may be judged two at a time.

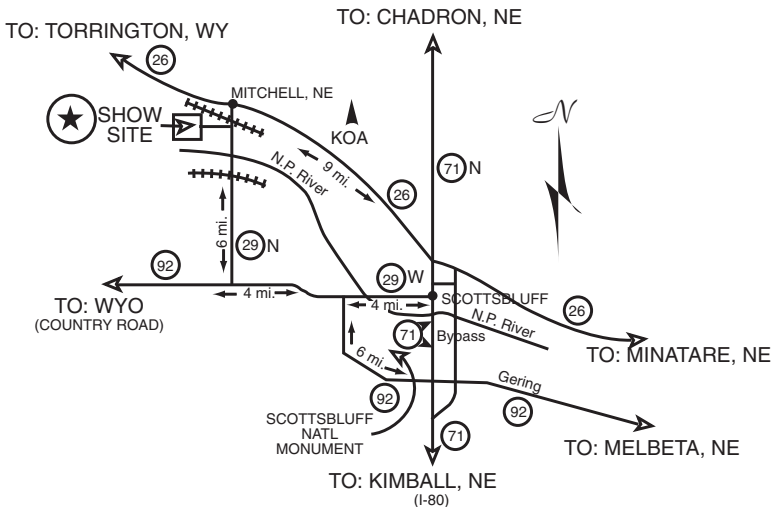
